Invitation

The Royal Yacht Club of Tasmania and Derwent Sailing Squadron invite owners and charterers of SB20s to enter the SB20 Australasian Grand Slam.

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2. Advertising

- 2.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 (Appendix 1 Advertising).
- 2.2 The Organising Authority reserves the right to refuse advertising by any boat, if it is considered offensive to public taste or if it contravenes the laws of the governments of Tasmania or Australia.
- 2.3 Competitors may be required to display event sponsor's names(s)/logo(s). If required, the Organising Authority will supply these items and they shall be affixed as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The Regatta is open to SB20 class boats.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing an on-line entry by 30 December 2016.
- 3.3 Late entries will be accepted by payment of an additional \$20 up to 1600 on Friday 13 January 2017.

4. Entry Fee

4.1 Entry Fee shall be \$50 for each boat.

6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be issued by Friday 13 January 2017 and will be available at the regatta office and on the SB20 website <u>http://www.sb20.com.au/</u>

7. Racing Area

The racing area will be the River Derwent from the Tasman Bridge to a line drawn from Cartwright's Point to Trywork Point.

8. Courses

Courses will be windward/leeward as described in the sailing instructions.

9. Scoring

- 9.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series. There will be a maximum of eight races.
- 9.2 When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.3 When six or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10. Prizes

Overall prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd.

11. Charter Boats

A limited number of charter boats are available from the local SB20 fleet. Anyone wishing to enquire about a charter boat should contact the Sailing Office of either of the Clubs on the email addresses listed below.

12. Safety

The Race Committee will operate on VHF Channel 10. All boats shall carry a working VHF radio and monitor Ch 10.

13. Disclaimer of Liability

All those participating in the 2017 Australasian Grand Slam races do so entirely at their own risk and responsibility.

ATTENTION is drawn to RRS4 Decision to Race.

The Royal Yacht Club of Tasmania, the Derwent Sailing Squadron, their executives, boards, servants, volunteers and agents and all other parties involved with the conduct and organisation of the event disclaim any and every responsibility for loss, damage, injury, death or inconvenience that might occur to persons or property, both ashore or afloat, as a consequence of participation in the race covered by this notice of race and by the sailing instructions.

14. Haulout Restriction

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta (wet regatta) except with prior permission of the Race Committee. SB20s will be berthed at RYCT and DSS.

15. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000.
