Women's Keelboat Invitational Race

Sunday 1 December, 2019

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RACE, VENUE AND ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

- 1.1 The Women's Keelboat Invitation race will be sailed on the waters of Gulf St Vincent.
- 1.2 The organizing authority is the Royal South Australian Yacht Squadron (RSAYS), Oliver Rogers Road, Outer Harbor SA.

2 RULES

The race will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing (AS).

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1 The Women's Keelboat Invitation race is open to keel boats and individual team crews registered with AS affiliated clubs.
- 3.2 Boats shall be helmed for the entire race by a lady who is a member of an AS affiliated club.
- 3.3 Boats entered in the RSAYS Combined Women's Series are not required to complete the Entry Form as they are automatic entrants free of charge.
- 3.4 Boats shall comply with Category 6 requirements as described in the AS Special Regulations Part 1 SECTION 2 and submit a Safety Declaration form with their Entry unless they have already submitted one with their club for the current season.
- 3.5 Eligible boats and teams may enter by completing the online entry form on the RSAYS website and lodging, together with the entry fee by 1700 Friday 29 November 2019.
- 3.6 The RSAYS will provide yachts on a first come basis to individual teams. A limited number of boats is available.
- 3.7 An entry fee of \$25.00 per boat or \$80.00 per team is aplicable.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1 Sign-on sheets will be available at RSAYS, CYCSA and PASC. Competitors shall sign on at least 1 hour prior to the warning signal.
- 4.2 Boats should display the designated class flag from their backstay or, conspicuously if no backstay.

4.3 Race Schedule

Division	Class Flag	Warning Signal
Division 1	E flag	1255 hrs
Division 2	F flag	1255 hrs

4.4 Trophy presentations will take place approximately 1½ hours after the last boat finishes at the RSAYS.

5. TIME LIMIT

For all Divisions is 4 hours. Boats failing to finish within the time limit shall be scored DNF. This changes rule 35.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS & COURSE

The Sailing Instructions will be available from the Boating Office of RSAYS, CYCSA and PASC and online through the RSAYS web site, at least 2 hours before the first warning signal.

7. SCORING

PHS results using Top Yacht will be calculated from handicaps determined by the RSAYS Handicap Committee.

8 PROTESTS

Boats intending to protest shall lodge a protest form in accordance with RRS Part 5 within 1 hour of finishing or retiring. In addition she shall notify the RC boat of her intent, naming the parties involved.

9. PRIZES

- 9.1 The Women's Keelboat Invitational Race will be awarded to the winning boat overall on handicap.
- 9.2 For 7 or more entrants, prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd.
- 9.3 For 5-6 entries, prizes will be awarded for 1st and 2nd.

10 LIABILITY DISCLAIMER/ INSURANCE

- 10.1 The RSAYS will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.
- 10.2 The RSAYS reserves the right to refuse to accept an entry from any boat or team.
- 10.3 Attention is drawn to the Fundamental Rules of Part 1 particularly Rule 4: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone'.
- 10.4 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per event or equivalent.
