

Darwin Sailing Club 2019 Arafura Short Offshore Point Score Series Sailing Instructions – Anglers Reef 18th May 2019

Start time: 1000.

Offshore Series Race 1 Anglers Reef

Div. 1, 2, 3 & 4,

Start between E buoy and DSC Tower, No.1 Buoy(s), Anglers Reef virtual mark(s), O Buoy(p), Finish. is a transit between E buoy and Emery point, leaving E buoy to starboard.

Note 1:

"DSC Tower" will conduct a sign-on session, on VHF Channel 73, commencing 20 minutes prior to the scheduled start time for a safety radio check and to confirm crew.

Note 2:

All boats must take their own finishing time and transmit them to the Sailing Manager on sailingmanager@dwnsail.com.au before 1500hrs Sunday 19th May 2019. Entrants failing to submit their time and course completion declaration by this time will be scored DNF.

This race is a Cat 4 Safety - all Skippers to sign declaration.

Note 3: Boats may be required to carry a tracker supplied by the club. This must be turned on at all times during the race.

Starting Sequence:

The starting sequence will be by VHF Ch.73. No flags will be used.

5 minutes before start: Warning signal by VHF Ch.73 – no flag

4 Minutes before start: Radio call VHF Ch. 73
1 Minute before start: Radio call VHF Ch. 73

Start: Radio call VHF Ch. 73

Starting order:

There will be one start for all divisions



Marks:

E Buoy: 12°25.560' S 130°48.800' E

No. 1 Buoy 12°20.596' S 130°42.907 E

Anglers Reef Virtual Mark 12°19.000'S 130°51.500' E

CAUTION: Anglers reef is to the east of this virtual mark.

The Anglers Reef waypoint has an associated rounding/passing quadrant defined as the area enclosed between two bearing lines (with 90° between them) extending from the waypoint. The bearing lines are 012° and 102°. A boat that provides a valid GPS fix within this quadrant is deemed to have rounded or passed the waypoint on the correct side.
