SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5th March 2024

The Organising Authority will be:
Wangi Amateur Sailing Club (WASC)
Under the authority of Australian Sailing (AS)
Hosted by WASC located at Watkins Road Wangi Wangi NSW 2267 Australia

1 RULES

- 1.1 Races will be governed by the 2021 - 2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) as amended, including the Australian Sailing (SA) prescriptions 2021-2024 and Appendix T shall apply.
- 1.2 Competitors shall comply with the AS Special Regulations applicable for Category 7 or above.
- 1.3 RRS 44.1 Penalty System is changed so that the Two Turns Penalty is replaced by the One Turn Penalty. (changes RRS44.1)

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors shall be posted on the noticeboard at WASC, located adjacent to the entrance to the club as well as the WASC website under Regattas.

3 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Changes to the Sailing Instructions shall be issued no later than two hours prior to the first warning signal and no later than 1800 hours on the preceding day for a change in the schedule of the race.
- 3.2 Changes to sailing Instructions will be signaled by Code flag L displayed ashore.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals ashore will be displayed from the Official Flagpole located on the waterfront at WASC.

5 RACING CONDITIONS

- 5.1 The race will be conducted and scored per NOR (Point 7)
- 5.2 All boats should carry a VHF radio turned on and tuned to channel 77.
- 5.3 A boat retiring before, during or after a race, shall notify the RC of its intention to do so by calling the RO on 4975 4212 or VHF (Channel 77) at the earliest opportunity.
- 5.4 Any boat retiring from a race and failing to advise the RC will be scored DNC. (Changes RRS 63.1 and A5.3).

6 PROHIBITED AREAS

- 6.1 The shoreline and moored boats shall be designated as obstructions and competitors are not allowed to go within 30 metres of moored boats whilst racing.
- 6.2 All Cardinal navigation marks shall be passed on their safe waterside.

7 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 7.1 A competitors briefing will be held in the Wangi RSL club at 11:30 on the day of the race.
- 7.2 The first warning signal will be at 12:25.
- 7.2 A re-sail for an abandoned race may be scheduled at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- 7.3 Abandonment of a race due to adverse weather shall be at the discretion of the Race Committee until 1 hour prior to the warning signal and thereafter at the discretion of the Race Officer.

8 STARTING TIME AND SIGNALS

Boats will be allocated to one of the four following groups for the purpose of starting. Warning signals will be a coloured flag or board displayed on the deck of WASC

Group	Warning Signal Colour	Time of Warning Signal
Group 1	Blue	12:25
Group 2	Yellow	12:35
Group 3	Green	12:45
Group 4	White	12:55

9 THE COURSES

- 9.1 Courses shall be those set out in Appendix 1. For a map showing the approximate locations of Marks, refer to Appendix 2.
- 9.2 An International code flag numeral shall be flown on the deck of WASC prior to the warning signal to indicate the course number to be sailed.

10 MARKS

- 10.1 All marks, including the start/finish mark, shall be a lime green cylinder approximately 1300mm high and 300mm in diameter, with a 150mm wide black band approximately 400mm down from the top and inscribed with the letters WASC.

11 THE START

- 11.1 The start for each group will be in accordance with RRS26, in addition this may be supplemented by a countdown on VHF radio (Channel 77).
- 11.2 The start line will be a line drawn an orange flag displayed on the deck of WASC and the start mark (club).

12 RECALLS

- 12.1 Individual Recalls shall be in accordance with RRS 29.
- 12.2 In addition, the Race Officer (RO) may broadcast on VHF radio (Channel 77) the sail number of a boat that is On Course Side (OCS). A failure to make such broadcast or to receive such broadcast will not be considered as grounds for redress. (Changes RRS 62.1(a)).

13 FINISH LINE

- 13.1 The Finish line will be a line drawn between a Blue flag displayed on the deck of WASC Clubhouse and the finishing mark (club).
- 13.2 Boats that have finished shall keep clear of boats that are still racing.

14 TIME LIMIT

The time limit will be three hours from the first start signal (Group 1). Yachts not finishing within the time limit will be recorded as DNF. (Changes RRS35)

15 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

15.1 Protest and Request for Redress forms are available upstairs at WASC and shall be lodged within 1 hour of the finish time of the last boat.

Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses and the time and location of the hearing.

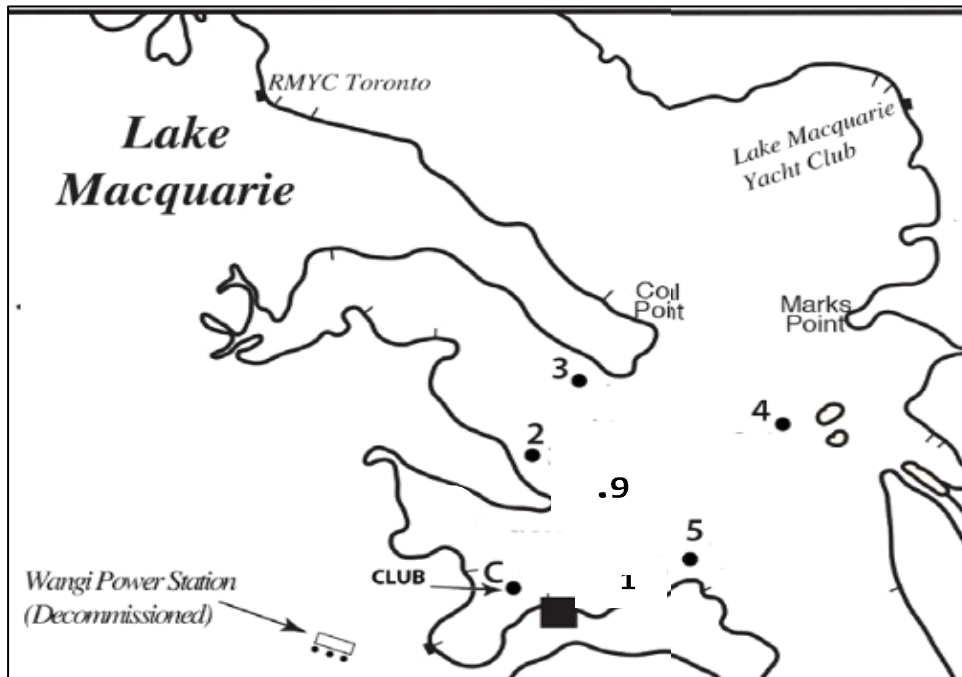
