The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the SI means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 **RULES**

- The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. 1.1
- The Prescriptions of Australian Sailing will apply. 1.2
- 1.3 The Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 – Off The Beach Boats shall apply.
- RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two Turns Penalty is replaced by the One Turn Penalty. 1.4
- 1.5 RRS T1(b) is changed so that the Post Race Penalty of a 30% Scoring Penalty is replaced by a 20% Scoring Penalty calculated as stated in RRS 44.3(c).

2 **NOTICES TO COMPETITORS**

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located near Registration.

3 **CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Change to the sailing instructions may be made at any time. Verbal notification will be made as well as posting on the notice board.

- 4.1 As many races as possible will be scheduled
- 4.5 No warning signal will be made after 1500.

5 **CLASS FLAGS**

The Class flags will be the class insignias. The Petersen Group will use the Laser flag.

RACING AREAS 6

The racing area will be to the North of the King Street Bridge.

7 **THE COURSES**

- 7.1 Courses will be as displayed on the Notice Board and described at the briefing.
- Courses may be aligned to the physical location of the racing area, not the wind direction. 7.2
- 7.3 All rounding marks are to be left to port.
- The Course number will be displayed on a board at the starting position and may be hailed by the 7.3 Race Officer.

8 MARKS

- 8.1 Marks will be orange buoys.
- 8.3 The starting marks will be orange pin buoys.
- 8.4 The finishing marks will be orange pin buoys

9 THE START

9.1 Races will be started by using a 3 minute start sequence.

Warning Signal 3 min to start Class Flag

Prep Signal2 min to startP or U or Black flag1 Min Signal1 min to startRemove Prep SignalStartRemove Class Flag

- 9.2 The starting line will be between 2 orange flags on the starting marks.
- 9.3 A boat that does not start within 3 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A4 and A5.

10 THE FINISH

The finishing line will be between 2 orange flags on the starting marks.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

12 TIME LIMITS AND TARGET TIMES

- 12.1 The target time for races is 20 minutes
- 12.2 The time limit for the first boat in each race shall be 40 minutes
- Boats failing to finish within 10 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5.

13 ARBITRATION & POST RACE PENALTIES

- 13.1 Appendix T Arbitration shall apply.
- 13.2 RRS T1(b) Post Race Penalty of a 30% Scoring Penalty is replaced by a 20% Scoring Penalty calculated as stated in RRS 44.3(c).

14 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 14.1 Protest forms are available from the registration desk. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered there as soon as possible on coming off the water.
- 14.2 The protest time limit is 15 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of a session.
- 14.3 Penalties may be less than disqualification if the protest committee so decide. The scoring abbreviation for a discretionary penalty imposed under this instruction will be DPI.

17 SCORING

- 17.2 The regatta will consist of as many races as possible. 2 races must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 17.3 (a) When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When from five (5) to seven (7) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - (c) 8 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

18 SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 18.3 A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee as soon as possible [DP]
- 18.5 <u>Personal Floatation Devices.</u> Competitors are reminded that it is a requirement under Australian Sailing Special Regulations that they wear approved personal flotation devices at all times while afloat and not just when racing. [DP]

23 SUPPORT BOATS – RRS Definition Support person

23.1 Support boats are not permitted on the Patawalonga Lake.

25 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

26 PRIZES

26.1 12.1. The following prizes will be awarded;

Opti Cup – Optimist

Bic Cup - Open Bic

Tillett Trophy – International Cadet

Petersen Trophy – Other classes on Yardstick

- 12.2. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.
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27 MEDIA


28 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY




29 INSURANCE
