



COVID Safe Guidelines

- . Do not come to dodgeball if you are feeling unwell or have flu like symptoms.
- . We recommend downloading the COVIDSafe app to assist with contact tracing in the event of an outbreak.
- . Hand sanitiser will be available at the entrance to each court and all players are required to use it before entering.
- . Players are encouraged to change into their dodgeball gear prior to attending the centre to reduce usage of communal areas such as bathrooms.
- . All balls and equipment will be sanitised.
- . Players are not to mingle in large groups before and after matches. Come, play and leave to reduce the amount of numbers in the centre at any one time.
- . Players are not to high five or handshake after matches, please use alternative non-contact methods.
- . Spectators are required to maintain 1.5m distance from each other and follow any signage on seating spacing.
- . Pre-registration is required for all drop-in dodgeball to ensure we have accurate record for contact tracing.
- . Contactless payment ONLY.
- . Outboxes will be extended to allow extra space between eliminated players.
- . Our venues will have their own COVID Safe processes in place, please abide by all signage and staff instructions when you arrive and interact with the centre.
