

# RYCT SHOWDOWN 31 OCTOBER & 1 NOVEMBER 2020 NOTICE OF RACE

## SB20 & International Dragon

#### (Off the Beach Boats and 2.4s are covered by a separate Notice of Race)

#### **Organising Authority: The Royal Yacht Club of Tasmania**

The Royal Yacht Club of Tasmania invites owners and charterers of SB20s and International Dragons to enter the 2020 RYCT Showdown.

#### **1.** Rules

The regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

#### 2. Advertising

- 2.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 (Appendix 1 Advertising).
- 2.2 The Organising Authority reserves the right to refuse advertising by any boat, if it is considered offensive to public taste or if it contravenes the laws of the governments of Tasmania or Australia.
- 2.3 Competitors may be required to display event sponsor's names(s)/logo(s). If required, the Organising Authority will supply these items and they shall be affixed as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The Regatta is open to SB20 and International Dragon class boats. Helms and crews shall be members of a club affiliated with Australian Sailing.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing an on-line entry by 16:00 on Wednesday 28 October 2020.
- 3.3 Late entries may be accepted by payment of an additional \$10 up to 16:00 on Thursday 29 October 2020.
- 3.4 An on-line entry system has been established on the Showdown website Enter Here

#### 4. Entry Fee

4.1 Entry Fee shall be \$90 for each boat.

#### 5. Schedule

#### 6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be issued by Friday 30 October 2020 and will be available at the RYCT and on the RYCT website.

#### 7. Racing Area

The racing area will be the River Derwent from the Tasman Bridge to a line drawn from Cartwright's Point to Trywork Point.

#### 8. Courses

Courses will be windward/leeward as described in the sailing instructions.

#### 9. Scoring

- 9.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series. There will be a maximum of eight races.
- 9.2 When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.3 When six or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

#### **10.** Prizes

Prizes will be presented based on the following table:

Entrants	1 to 3	3 to 5	6 to 10	10 to 18
Prizes	1 <sup>st</sup> - only	1st & 2nd	1 <sup>st</sup> to 3 <sup>rd</sup>	1 <sup>st</sup> to 5 <sup>th</sup>

#### **11.** Safety

It is recommended that entrants have a practised Man Overboard procedure that all crew members are made fully aware of.

#### **12.** Disclaimer of Liability

All those participating in the 2020 Showdown Regatta races do so entirely at their own risk and responsibility.

ATTENTION is drawn to RRS4 Decision to Race.

The Royal Yacht Club of Tasmania, their executives, boards, servants, volunteers and agents and all other parties involved with the conduct and organisation of the event disclaim any and every responsibility for loss, damage, injury, death or inconvenience that might occur to persons or property, both ashore or afloat, as a consequence of participation in the race covered by this notice of race and by the sailing instructions.

#### **13. Haulout Restriction**

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta (wet regatta) except with prior permission of the Race Committee.

#### 14. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000.
