## Procedure:

- 1. The *Referee* makes the initial decision regarding an event e.g. disqualification.
- 2. The Chief Referee confirms the Referees decision.
- 3. A written report is prepared by the protesting party and is submitted to the *CIS Swimming Carnival Convenor* by the *Association Swimming Team Manager*. (Protests directly from parents will not be accepted).
- 4. Protests must be received within 30 minutes from the completion of the event.
- 5. The *Chief Referee* reads the report and compiles their own report, which must be signed within one hour.
- 6. The *Jury*, consisting of:
  - A qualified NSW Swimming Official
  - Meet Manager Official
  - The CIS Swimming Carnival Convenor
  - 1 CIS Executive

makes the final decision.

7. The 'Matter of Fact' decision is made and is immediately passed on to the Association Swimming Team Manager by the CIS Swimming Convenor.

Parents are not to direct protests to the convenor. All protests must proceed through the appropriate Association Swimming Team Manager.
