NOTICE OF RACE

The organising authority, the Royal Yacht Club of Tasmania invites entries for this series to be held on the River Derwent on 14 & 15 March 2020.

1. Organising Authority

The Organising Authority is The Royal Yacht Club of Tasmania (RYCT)

2. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

Appendix T will apply to this regatta amended so that an Arbitrator may form part of a subsequent Protest Committee.

International Dragon Class Rule 13.30 (Crew Weight) will not apply to this regatta.

3. Eligibility

Each boat shall be registered with an AS affiliated club and the International Dragon Class Association.

At least one person on each boat must be a financial member of their State International Dragon Association.

Each boat shall hold a current measurement Certificate and a current valid Inventory of Required and Optional Equipment for the International Dragon Class.

Boats shall comply with AS Special Regulations Part 1, Category 7.

4. Entries

Entry shall be made by completing an on-line entry. The on-line entry can be found at:

Series entry fee will be \$130.

5. Schedule of Events

On Sunday 15 March no warning signal will be made after 1600.

6. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available at RYCT at Registration on Saturday 14 March 2020.

7. Courses

The courses will be windward/leeward as detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

8. Scoring

Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series. There will be a maximum of eight races. When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of

her race scores. When six to eight races have been completed, a boat's score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. Wet Regatta

Boats shall be launched by 10:00 on 14 March 2020 and shall remain in the water for the duration of the regatta.

10. Prizes

Will be presented at discretion of the Tasmanian International Dragon Association but will include the Barry Calvert Trophy for the best performed boat on the first three races, the Tasmanian International Dragon Class trophy for the best performed boat on Line Honours, the Cuthbertson Trophy for the best performed boat on PHS (TCFs as allocated by the Race Committee and not subject to protest or request for redress), and other trophies at the discretion of TIDA.

All those participating in the International Dragon Tasmanian Championship do so entirely at their own risk and responsibility. ATTENTION is drawn to RRS 4 (Decision to Race).
