1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Australian Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 Off the Beach Boats will apply (DP).
- 1.3 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located on the western window of the lower deck.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between the NOR and the SI's, the SI's will take precedence.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all Brighton & Seacliff Sailing Members and Sailing Members of any AYF affiliated Yacht Clubs.

Eligible Craft include - Off the Beach Dinghies, Catamarans, Sailboards, Trailerable Yachts and Keel Boats. Non current off the beach dinghy classes can register for the "Classic Fleet" but must be insured to the satisfaction of the RO.

- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing an online entry at https://www.revolutionise.com.au/bsyc/events/58816/
- 2.3 Late entries will be accepted by discretion of RO till 1st February 2020.

3. FEES

- 3.1 Senior Classes BSYC Sailing member free
 - Senior Classes Visitor Day 1 \$30 per sailor
 - Senior Classes Visitor Day 2 \$20 per sailor
 - Junior Classes BSYC Sailing member free
 - Junior Classes Visitor Day 1 \$15 per sailor
 - Junior Classes Visitor Day 2 \$10 per sailor
- 3.2 A late fee of \$20 will apply to entries received after 1st February 2020
- *Entry fee includes Regatta Entry, prizes, complimentary Gourmet Sausage, complimentary Cocktail Food and music.
 - **Complimentary Cocktail Food and music is available to sailors family and friends as well

4. VENUE

4.1 The Racing Area will be the waters of the Gulf of St Vincent off the Brighton & Seacliff Yacht Club, generally between Brighton Jetty, B&SYC and 1nm off shore.

- 5.1 1 race is scheduled on Saturday (a standalone event) and 2 Races scheduled on Sunday.
- 5.2 No warning signal will be made later than 1600hrs on 9th February 2020.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and may be posted on the Regatta web-site at a prior time.

7. THE COURSES:

7.1 Courses will be shown on a board in the lower deck.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1 For all classes RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 Low Point System will be used.
 - 4 + boats = own class, less than 4 boats will be scored on yardstick in a mixed fleet.
- 9.2 Day $1 1 \times 1 = 1 \times 1 =$
 - Day 2 2x races will constitute a series and both races shall count.

10. BERTHING

10.1 Boats shall be kept in the boat park – trailers taken home or on the beach.

11. RADIO COMMUNICATION

11.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

12. PRIZES

12.1 Prizes will be given at the discretion of the organisers, based on numbers in each division or class.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per event or equivalent.
