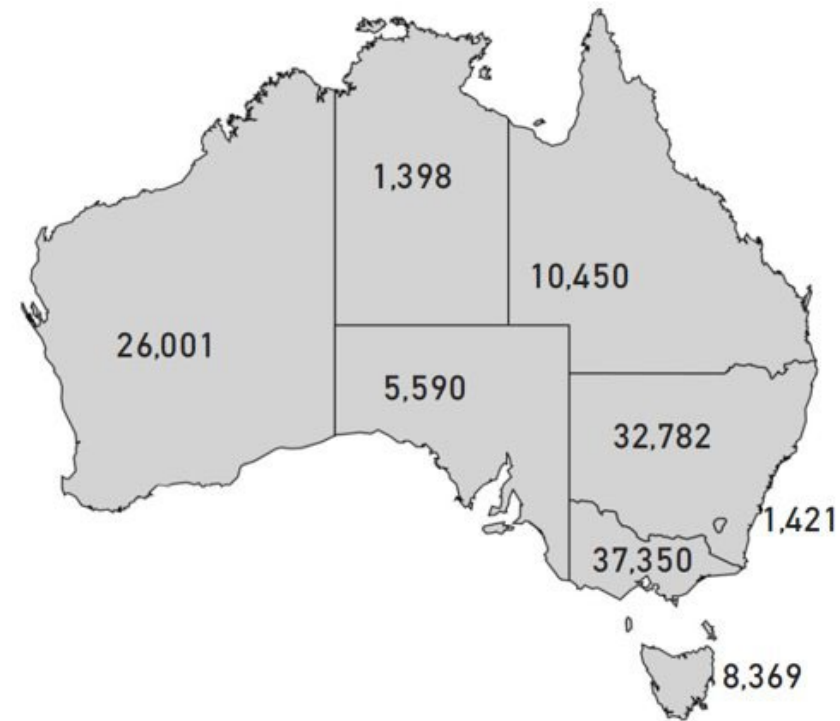
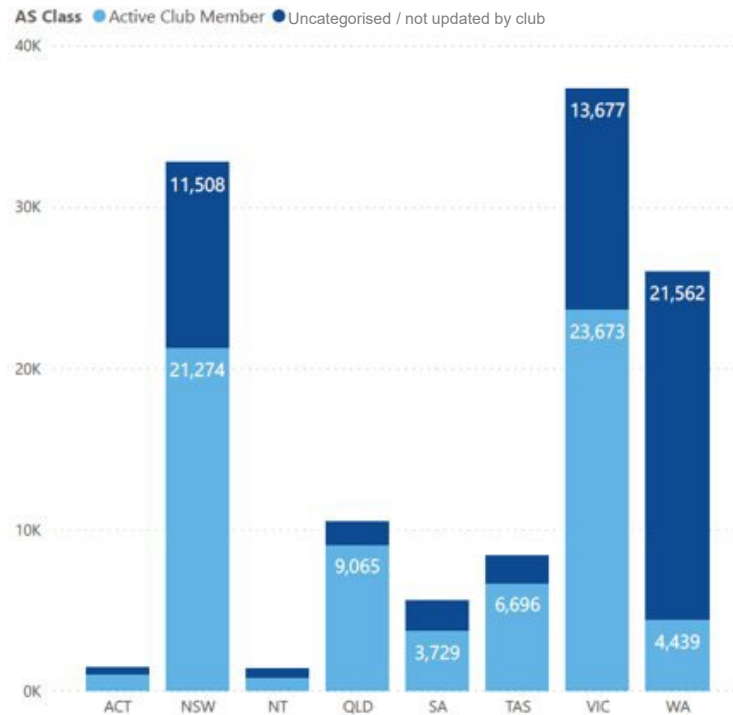

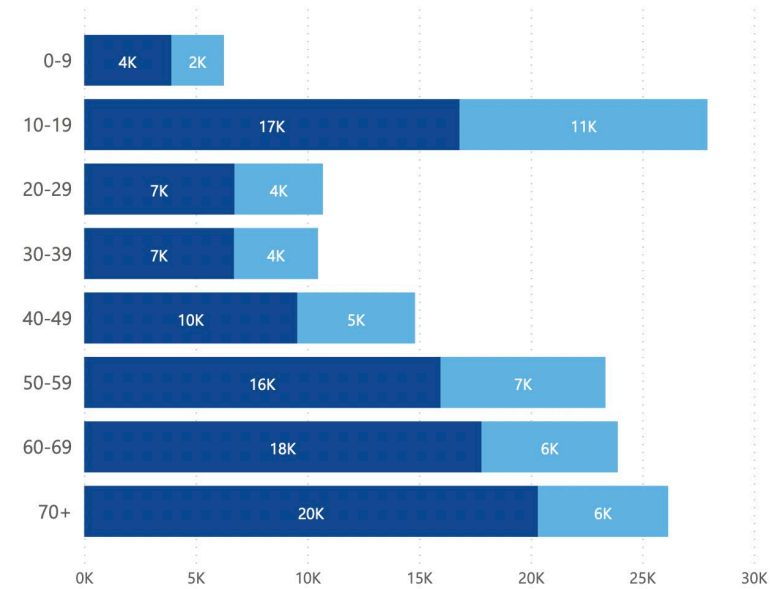

## Age & Gender



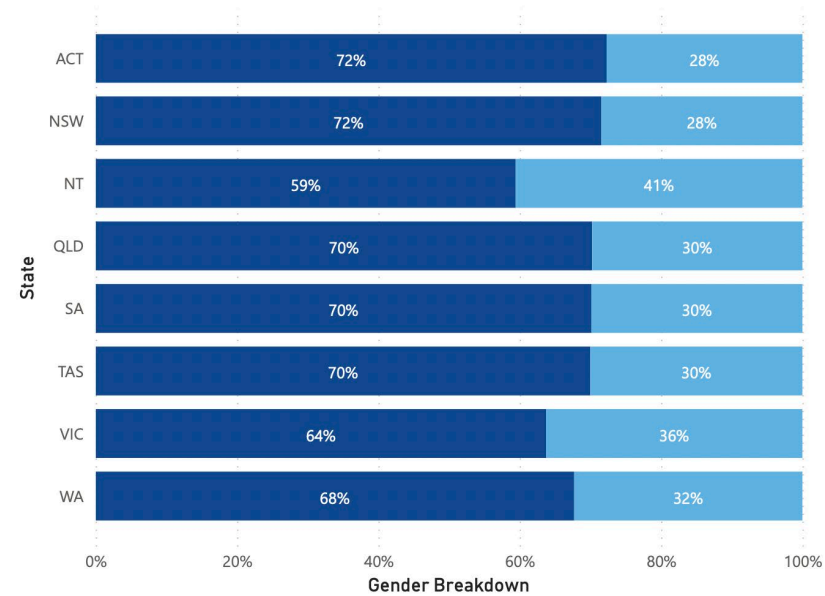
### Gender Balance & Age Breakdown


