Hours of training

The sailors will be instructing 22 new girls in a Learn to sail Courses Level 1 and Level 2 under my strict supervision. This course will run over the next 12 weeks on a Tuesday and Thursday giving them the hours and training they need.

Also any courses or joy ride that are booked they will assist in.

Skipper course

This is the difficult one as the cost is high, R2500 per student

So we have decided to go the difficult root. We are going to get the sailors their day skippers.

Day skippers will give these students a chance to get their keelboat instructors and they will be able to skipper our rescue vessels till one mile offshore. This will also open employment opportunities on charter boats and boat deliveries.

We will study on bad weather days in the next three months including July holidays. An examiner has been organised and he will provide us with mock paper.

We will practice and get our hours on Ellen however we will have to get a bigger boat to get our test done. We still in the process of enquiring with boat owners.

Radio licence.

It seems like this will be quite costly however, we have contacted a company that might be able to assist us at a more affordable price.

First aid

Rescue 911 have offered to provide a course to us at a reduced rate.

Safety boat course

Elfie Holden can present the course. We will just have to pay the necessary fee to South African Sailing.

Instructor course

All this will equip us for the Instructor course that we would like to happen in August/September. The cost per student is around R4000 per students. We will contact South African sailing to see if it is possible to get a reduced rate for our students.

A possibility would be that the foundation can sign a contract with the new instructors that they work back the funds through courses they present at the centre.
