- CELEBRATE those that have put in the most days with trophies
- Awards for best on-water and on-shore PARTICIPATION

- Make the certificate ceremony FUN and make mention of each person's contributions
- Provide branded shirts, hats, reusable water bottles help them feel a part of a group and SPECIAL
- Lunches, drinks on the day, gather after racing and make sure the person in charge thanks them
