



Who are you?

Queensland Regulated Ships (QRS) are broken down into two categories:

- recreational ship
- other Queensland regulated ship



Other Queensland regulated ship....

or QRS (other).

As part of an association, your ship is classified as an 'other Queensland regulated ship'.

This is a ship that is <u>not</u> a:


- recreational ship
- domestic commercial vessel (DCV)
- tender to a ship that is not a recreational ship or DCV



General Safety Obligation

All vessel owners and operators have a General Safety Obligation to operate vessels safely at all times that are:


- seaworthy
- properly equipped
- operated safely
- appropriately crewed



Your Safety Management System...

or SMS.


All owners or Masters of a QRS (other) must implement and maintain an SMS to ensure the safety of the crew and others, and to manage risk.



Your SMS

An SMS for a QRS (other) must include information outlined in the National Standard for Commercial Vessels Part E Operations (now Marine orders 504).

This also includes several operational requirements.



Aquatic event planning



What are aquatic events?

Aquatic events are held on or over water and include:


- sailing regattas
- boating schools
- swimming competitions
- water-skiing competitions
- powerboat races
- fireworks displays



Will the normal operation of ships be impacted?

If yes, you must obtain consent from Maritime Safety Queensland (MSQ).

To ensure the safety of all water users, an Aquatic Event Application Form must be submitted to MSQ to obtain an aquatic event authority.

Aquatic Event Authority Application

Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Act 1994 Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Regulation 2016

- An application to hold an aquatic event must be submitted to Maritime Safety Queensland/Gold Coast Waterways Authority no
 less than 30 days prior to the proposed start date for a 'low risk' event (e.g. sailing and yachting regatta, swimming race) and no
 less than 90 days prior to the proposed start date for a 'high risk' event (e.g. power boat race, watersking competition, fireworks
 display). An application may be refused if there is insufficient time to allow for due consideration of all marine safety aspects.
- The application form, supporting documents and applicable fee must be submitted to the relevant Maritime Safety Queensland regional office/Gold Coast Waterways Authority office.
- Evidence of Identity (EOI) must be provided by the applicant and representative (if applicable). Examples of EOI include: for individuals, a Queensland driver licence; and for organisations, a Certificate of Incorporation. For the complete list of acceptable documents refer www.tmr.gold.eov.au.
- · Additional information to accompany the application:

(if you have previously provided this information, ensure it has been updated for this application)

- a copy of a detailed chart/map of the area in which the proposed event is to take place
- a copy of the safety management plan and emergency response procedure
- a copy of current public liability insurance.
