

Your FAQs should complement information that exists elsewhere on your site



Write your questions from your customer's perspective and answer from your club's perspective



Consider how you can strategically raise the right questions to educate people how to get involved with your club.



Be sure to double-check your information. Your FAQ sections need to be accurate.


What should I bring sailing?

Some things that would be good to bring with you:

- Sunscreen
- Hat with a lanyard
- Sun glasses with a lanyard
- Towel

- A water proof jacket if it looks like rain
